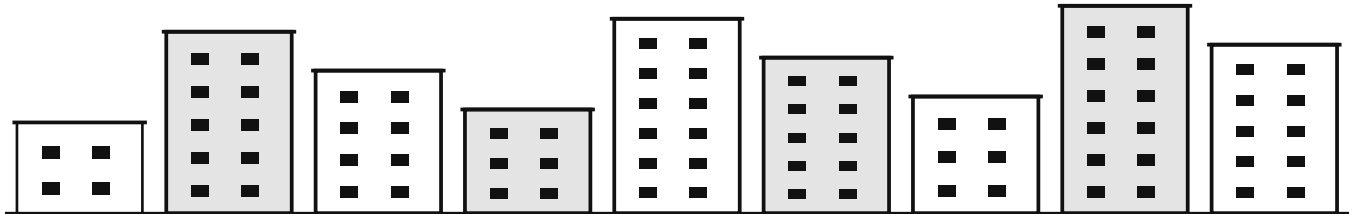

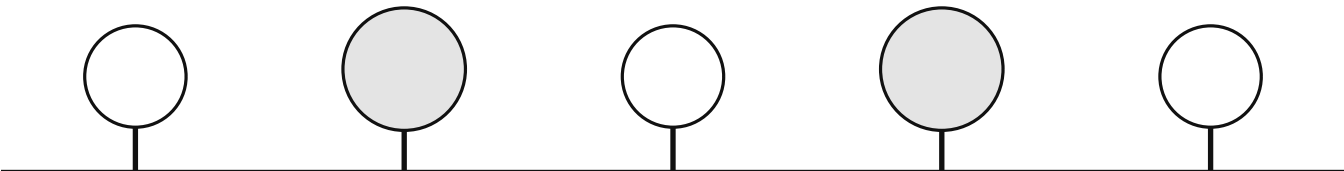
Convenience, Culture & Commute

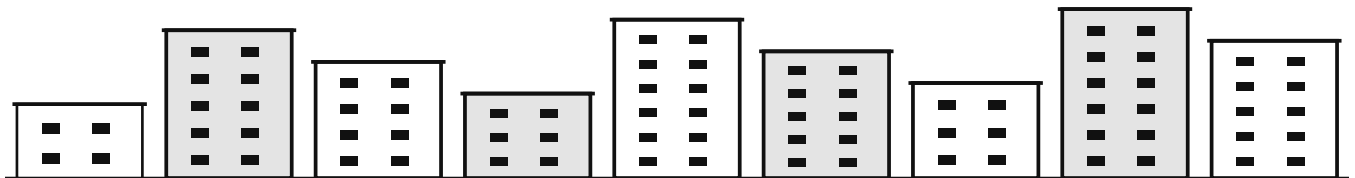
